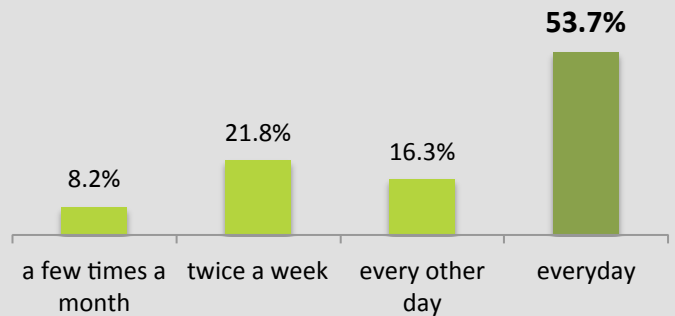
## How much ?

**1h** daily amount of screens' use by children

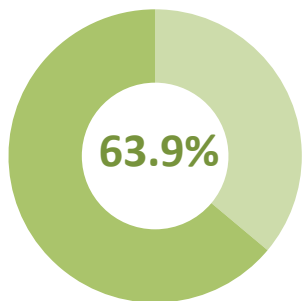
**19.7%** of 6-12 year olds own a smartphone

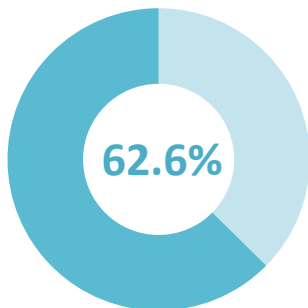
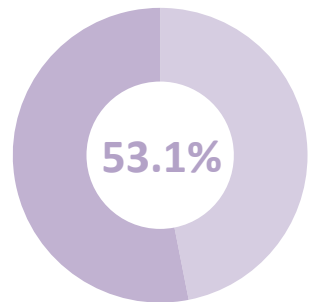

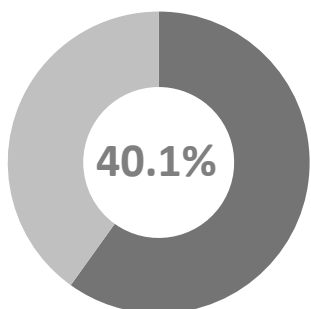


are **wondering** about the use of screens by their children

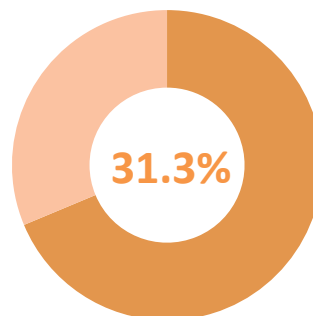
say that the use of screens by their children is a source of **concern**



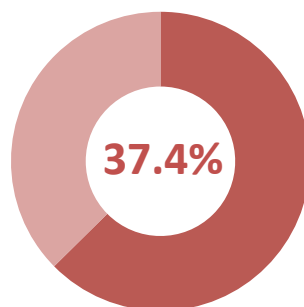
consider that the screens have an impact (positive or negative) on the **parent-child relationship**

\*Online survey of 150 French families with at least one child aged from 6 to 12 years

### The respondents

84.4% of mothers and 13.6% of fathers (other: 2%)

70.8% aged from 35 to 44 years

50.4% are high level educated

68.4% are employed or middle managers

Parents of : 49% of girls and 51% of boys (mean age: 8.54 years)



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
